

Riverview Corridor – Terms to Know

Right-of-Way (ROW)

- Legal definition of property ownership (e.g. where your property ends and someone else's starts).

Types of Transit Operations (Bus or Rail)

- **Dedicated** = Operates in its own lane (example: Green Line)
- **Shared Use** = Operates in mixed traffic (examples: buses (or rail) and cars share a lane or passenger rail and freight trains share a track).
- **Hybrid** = This is an alternative with characteristics of Dedicated AND Shared Use operations; attempt to balance needs of various users of right of way.

Basis of Concept

- How the Riverview Study defines a transit alternative to fit a specific right-of-way (example: roadway, railroad).

Typical Section (Cross Section)

- Illustrates widths of sidewalk, parking, travel and transit lanes
- Defines the footprint of an alternative to assess potential costs and benefits

Pinch Point

- A place where conflict is likely to occur due to:
 - Narrow ROW
 - Existing business and residential access
 - Environmental and natural features
 - Historic and cultural features
 - Built environment / 'public realm'
